



Youth On Their Own would like to thank our donors for their past donations. Due to storage and staff limitations, our donation policy is changing effective October 1, 2011.

Items Accepted for Donation:

- Non-perishable food items, especially Ramen Noodles, Macaroni & Cheese, Beans, Soup, Chili, Canned Vegetables, Peanut Butter & Jelly, Canned Tuna & Chicken, Spaghetti Sauce & Pasta, Rice, Breakfast Cereal, Baby Formula, etc. All food items must be within their expiration date.
- New or gently used, age-appropriate clothing & shoes for **teenage students**.
- New, regular size hygiene products such as shampoo, conditioner, skin lotion, toothpaste & toothbrushes, bar soap, body wash, shaving cream & razors, baby wash, etc.
- Gently used household appliances in good working order (e.g., toaster, coffee pot, microwave, dishes, etc.)
- Laundry Soap
- School supplies
- Diapers – all sizes

Items Not Accepted:

- Clothing not teen appropriate or something teens will not wear
- Non-working items of any kind (e.g., TVs, computers, coffee pots, etc.)
- Anything broken or missing parts so as to make it inoperable (e.g., Coffee maker with no carafe)
- Furniture, except on a case by case basis
- Expired food products of any kind
- Travel-size or partly used hygiene products
- Any items not listed above in accepted items

Items Accepted on a Case-by-Case Basis:

- Furniture, including twin mattresses
- Electronics
