- **CONDUCT A COMPREHENSIVE EVALUATION** of the YOTO program model.
- CONDUCT A STAKEHOLDER SURVEY to collect community input on the YOTO program and future growth plans.

BUILD CAPACITY

Enhance the organization's long-term sustainability through infrastructure and training, including:

- ESTABLISH SUCCESSION AND VACANCY COVERAGE PLANS for key staff and board positions.
- IMPROVE ORGANIZATION-WIDE IDEA AND TRAUMA-INFORMED CARE PRACTICES.
- CREATE AND IMPLEMENT TRAINING PROGRAMS for performance and change management.

STRENGTHEN SYSTEMS

Refine organizational systems that enable YOTO to efficiently serve youth now and position YOTO for future growth, including:

- **REVIEW AND UPDATE** organizational and departmental policies, procedures, and internal controls.
- ADOPT AN INTEGRATED COMMUNICATIONS STRATEGY.
- OPTIMIZE DONOR DATA to enhance fundraising.

Invest in the development and expansion of burgeoning YOTO programs and initiatives, including:

- ENHANCE PROGRAM MODEL and build infrastructure for services benefiting YOTO alumni.
- FURTHER BUILD THE YOUTH ACTION BOARD and implement youth voice in organizational decision-making.
